

Code of conduct For Youth Court attendees at the Annual youth court conference
2026 UYCA Summer Conference

1. Maintain integrity.
2. Maintain the Dress Code for the conference.
3. Maintain a courteous, objective and civil attitude during the conference.
4. Maintain all aspects of the Constitution of the USA and the State of Utah, Charter and By-laws of youth court.
5. Maintain respect for others attending the conference and all personnel helping at the conference.
6. Follow the rules set by the UYCA for attendance at the conference.
 - All youth are to stay at the Hotel/ Campus or with an advisor. Anyone caught leaving the premises without permission will be sent home.
 - Respect each other, yourself, and the property of the Conference facilities.
 - Make sure your adult supervisor knows where you are at all times.
 - Lights out is 11:00 p.m. All youth must be in their rooms. QUIET TIME.
 - Parents will be called and requested to pick up any youth causing disturbance at the hotel/dorms.
 - There will be a ZERO TOLERANCE for youth mingling in rooms other than their own.
 - ALL participants must wear their name badges at all times.
 - Your group will be responsible for any costs for any damages to any conference facility and any charges for any lost keys and/or damages to the rooms you were assigned.
 - We require school dress while attending the conference.
 - Be on time to all events.
 - Cell phones will be put away or silenced during conference activities.
7. Avoid improper conduct means the following but not inclusively:
 - Physical, sexual, or mental abuse
 - Endangering lives or welfare of others
 - Harassment, creation of a hostile environment or actions causing others to feel uncomfortable.
 - Acts of retaliation towards any persons at the conference or staff
 - Violations of ethical principles espoused by UYCA
 - Violations of the law

Depending on the violation of any of these code of conducts, if a youth violates any of these:

- The first offense will be a verbal warning.
- The second offense will be a warning to the youth and a call to the parents.
- The third offense will be handled by the advisor calling the parent for them to come and remove their child from the conference.
- The UYCA may decide to have a youth who has been removed, not be allowed to attend any further conferences.
